A local law EXPANDING THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR VILLAGE JUSTICE AND ACTING VILLAGE JUSTICE

SECTION I. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE

1.01 The Village Board of the Village of Rushville finds that in order to ensure that the people of the Village are properly served by an elected Village Justice and, when necessary, an appointed Acting Village Justice, it is necessary to expand the geographical area from which to select individuals who are eligible candidates for those offices.

1.02 The purpose of this Local Law is to:
Expand the residency requirements for the elected office of Village Justice and the appointed office of Acting Village Justice.

SECTION II. DEFINITIONS

2.01 Candidate for Office of Village Justice - Any individual seeking to run for the elected office of Village Justice may be a resident of the county in which the Village of Rushville is wholly

or partially situate.

Candidate for Appointment as Acting Village Justice - Any individual being considered for the appointed office as Acting Village Justice may be a resident of the county in which the Village of Rushville is wholly or partially situate.

SECTION III. AMENDMENT OF VILLAGE LAW

The foregoing Local Law is enacted pursuant to §3-300(2)(a) and (b) of the Village Law of the State of New York, and, where applicable, specifically amends §3-300 of the Village Law of the State of New York. Where not so amended, §3-300 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY

If any section, part of a section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or work of this Local Law is for any reason held or declared to be unconstitutional, inoperative or void, such holding or invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this Local Law.

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall become effective upon its adoption and filing as required by law.
